

Convention Tours

Thursday:

1. St. Rose Chapel and Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe escorted tour.

St Rose Convent is the Home of the Sisters of Perpetual Adoration. Its chapels are among the most popular and prominent visitor sites in La Crosse. Dedicated in 1906, the chapels together comprise 6,000 square feet and are on the list of historical sites. For a trip in time and culture, come tour the Romanesque chapels that have garnered national attention.

The Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe rests in a beautiful setting just south of La Crosse. It is the site of many pilgrimages and is visited by thousands of visitors each year. The Shrine consists of the magnificent shrine church which holds 450 people and is constructed in the cruciform design. On site is a votive candle chapel, memorial to the unborn, and outdoor stations of the cross.

2. Dahl Automobile Museum

Take a stroll down memory lane and immerse yourself in the rich history of the automobile. Dahl Auto Museum celebrates the Dahl family's involvement as auto dealers spanning over 100 years and five generations. It also features the history of the automobile, an extensive mascot collection and many beautiful classic automobiles from the turn of the 20th century to the present. Admission \$4.00

3. Riverboat Brunch Cruise on the La Crosse Queen with 3rd VP Choi

Enjoy brunch fit for a queen while you enjoy the sights along "Ol Man River." Includes hot and cold breakfast and lunch entrees. To make the morning special you will experience "locking thru" at Lock and Dam #7. Narrated tour included. Cost is \$32.00. Boat leaves at 11:00 am

4. Hixon House

The Hixon House is a beautiful look back in time at an authentic Victorian home. The Hixon House has approximately 90% of its original furnishings, making it unusual among historic houses and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Begun in 1859 by lumber baron Gideon Hixon, this Italianate house features beautiful woodwork and lavish interior decoration. "His wife, Ellen, decorated the Hixon House in the Aesthetic fashion, and it has been preserved much as it was after its last remodeling and redecoration around the 1900's. The house contains one of the few remaining "Turkish Nooks" in the country, a space designed to evoke an oriental atmosphere. Beautiful woodwork, original furnishings, and charming gardens make the tour a truly enjoyable experience for young and old alike." Cost = \$10. Minimum of 10 people.
