Dear Lion Friends,

This will be the third year for Wisconsin Lions Missions to conduct an eyeglass project in El Salvador. We have had excellent cooperation for the past two years and have high expectations for another successful project.

At the present time I have registration commitments from approximately half of the 32 volunteers needed for this project, so there is still room.

The El Salvador project will run from the arrival date of Sunday, February 25, 2018 to the departure date of Sunday, March 4, 2018. The mission immediately follows the project in Nicaragua led by Steve McCabe. This schedule allows for some participants that may be interested in volunteering for both projects to schedule a multi-destination flight, and assist us in transporting equipment to the next site.

The project is being planned for Usulután, the fifth largest city in El Salvador, located in the southeast region of the country. We will be working with the Usulután Lions Club, a foundation (in order to get the glasses shipped in duty-free), and the military. The military will assist with transportation, and we will be setting up in the facilities of the sixth brigade.

To register please send a \$100 check made out to me. This is used to assist the local club in providing meals for the week and to tip the hotel staff. Later in the process I will need the medical information form and waiver signed, similar to last year.

I hope that all is well, and would like to hear from you soon.
